JOB TITLE: Ratings Forming Part of a Navigational Watch Lecturer

Job Summary

Duties include lecturing experience in Ratings Forming Part of a Navigational Watch programmes with supervision of a class size of fifteen students and the equipment used to conduct the training exercises. He/she is responsible for planning the training presentations and course schedule in accordance with Section A-II/4 of the STCW Convention and Code. The lecturer is expected to have the minimum knowledge and experience as a Navigational Watch Officer onboard ships 500 gross tonnage and more.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Preparation of Power Points for theoretical training.
- Supervision of students and equipment.
- Seamanship Knowledge
- Conducts practical exercises in the use of magnetic and gyro-compasses.
- Conduct practical exercises in Helm orders.
- Communicate effectively how to change-over from automatic to hand steering and vice versa.
- Demonstration of proper look-out by sight and hearing.
- Impart knowledge effectively of how to control and monitor a safe watch.
- Demonstrating how to operate emergency equipment and apply emergency procedures.

- The holder of a II/5 Certification
- Minimum of one(1) year lecturing experience
